## An Act to amend the Customs Tariff Ordinance

[29TH JANUARY, 1964]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff Ordinance (Amend-Short title ment) Act, 1964, shall be read as one with the Customs Tariff Ordinance, and comand shall be deemed to have come into operation on the twenty-ninth mencement Cap. 346 day of January, 1964.
