An Act to amend the National Service Act, 1964

[18TH SEPTEMBER, 1964]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanganyika and Zanzibar.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the National Service (Amendment) Act, Short title 1964, and shall be read as one with the National Service Act, 1964 (here-construction inafter referred to as the "principal Act"). Acts 1964 No. 16
 - 2. Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows:-

Section 2 of

- (a) in the definition "member", by inserting, immediately after the amended word and figure "section 5", the words, figure and letter "or appointed to the permanent staff under section 5A"; and
- (b) in the definition "Serviceman", by inserting, immediately after the word and figure "section 5", the words, figure and letter "or appointed to the permanent staff under section 5A".
- 3. Section 4 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, Section 4 of immediately after the word and figure "section 5" in subsection (2), principal Act is the permanent staff the words, figure and letter "or appointed to the permanent staff under section 5A".
- 4. The principal Act is hereby amended by adding immediately New section 54 inserted below section 5 the following new section: in principal Act

"Appointments to permanent staff

5A.—(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) or (2) of section 5, appointments may be made to the permanent staff of the National Service on terms other than those prescribed in the said subsections and a citizen appointed to the permanent staff shall, so long as he holds such an appointment, be a Serviceman.

- (2) The power to make an appointment of an officer on the permanent staff is vested in the President.
- (3) In this section, 'officer' means a person holding a rank declared by rules made under section 21 to be an officer rank.".
