An Act to amend certain Written Laws

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Written Laws (Miscellaneous Short title Amendments) Act, 1985.

(2) The amendments to the Local Authorities Elections Act, 1979, Amendathe Local Government (District Authorities) Act, 1982 and the Local ment of Covernment (Urban Authorities) Act, 1982 shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1983.
